Well, the big day has finally arrived. We have learned a lot during the past ten weeks of rehearsals. The Miracle Worker is an incredible play about the early childhood of Helen Keller and her teacher, Annie Sulliven.

Through the course of the play, we see Helen's frustration as she struggles to break through her prison of blindness and deafness. Silence is used to help the audience experience a part of Helen's world.

We meet a young woman, Annie Sulliven, who has been blind herself and now attempts to teach a blind child to see.
