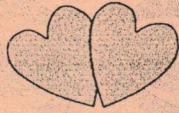

Three months later. Cartilage Creek goes bone-dry.

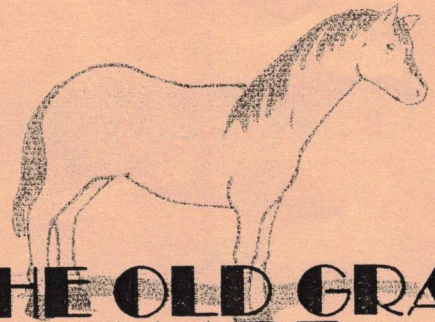


DAISY
