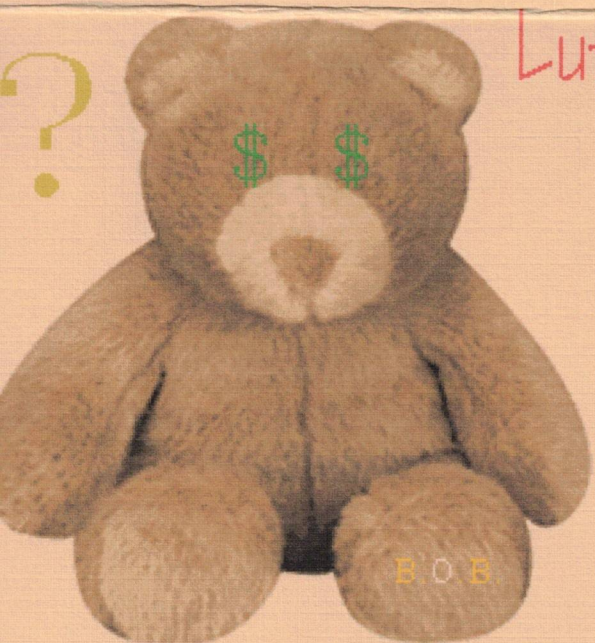
The Curious Savage
