Director's Note

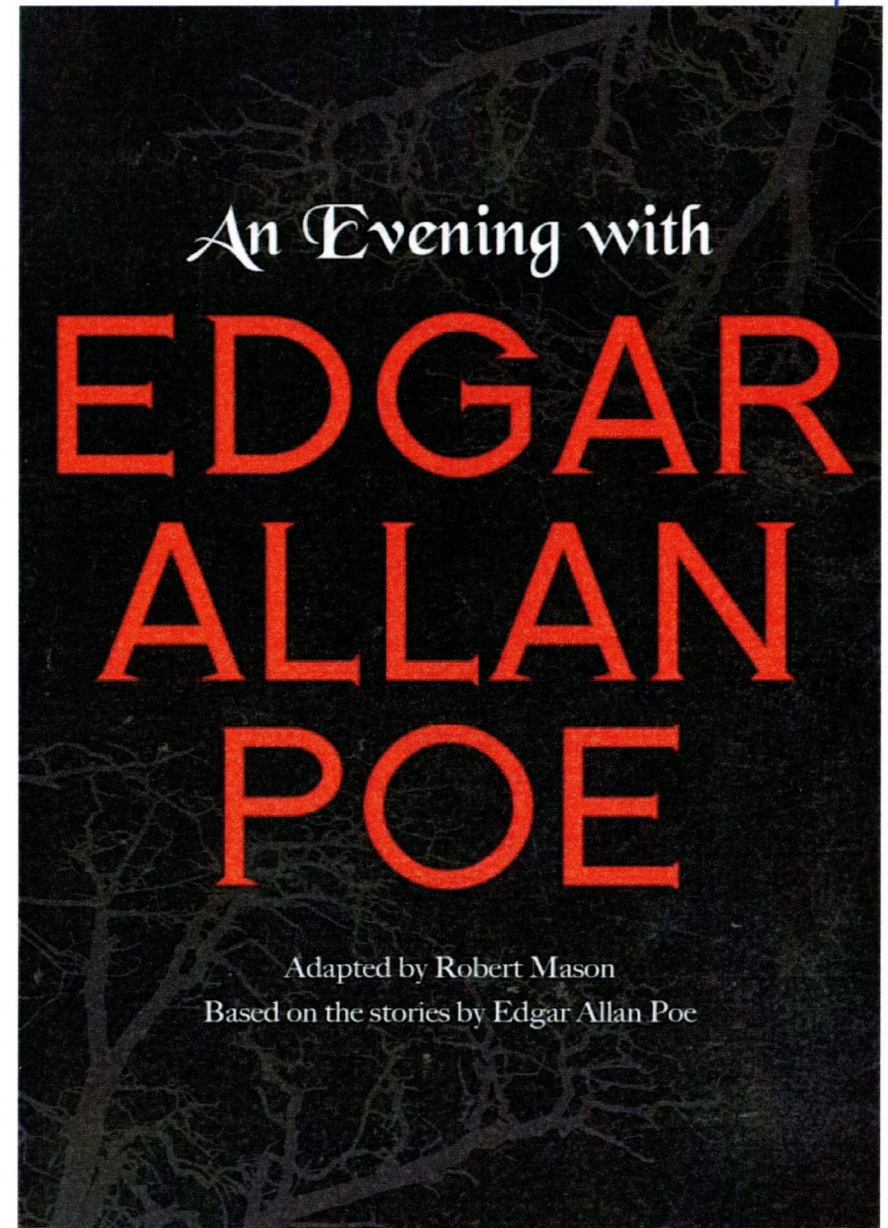
