Dr. Donald Christian was named the Dean of the College of Business for Concordia University at Austin in the Fall of 2005. For the five years previous to that, Dr. Christian served as Headmaster at Lutheran High North. Over those five years, the school grew in both student enrollment and reputation, establishing quality programs in academics, athletics, and fine arts as well as a strong student service learning component within the community.

Mr. Christian received his Doctor of Management in Organizational Leadership degree from the University of Phoenix. In addition to his work at Concordia, he also presently serves on the Board of LINC-Houston.

Prior to his work at Lutheran High North, Dr. Christian served in a variety of leadership positions, including Associate Director of the Lutheran Education Association of Houston, Parish Life Administrator at Trinity Lutheran Church in downtown Houston, and as a high school band director. He earned a Masters in Music and Wind conducting from the University of Cincinnati in 1986, and completed his undergraduate work at Concordia University River Forest (Illinois) 1981.

Don is married to Deborah Christian who serves as an English teacher and college admissions coordinator at Concordia Academy, Austin's Lutheran high school.
