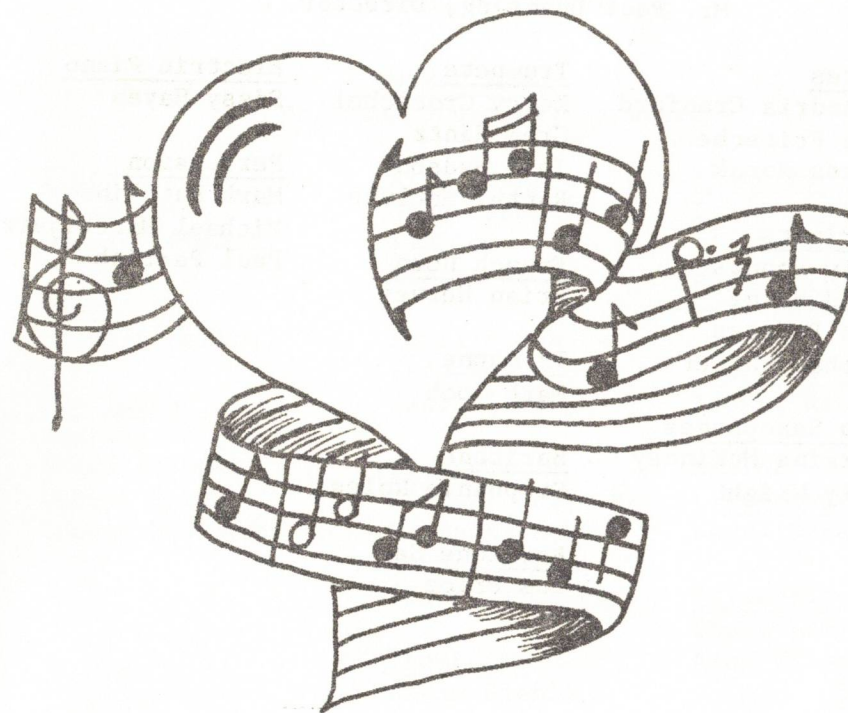

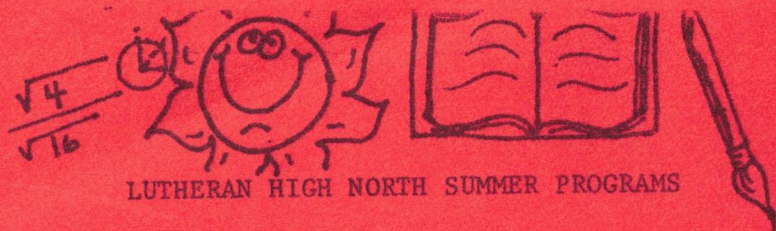

LUTHERAN HIGH NORTH SUMMER PROGRAMS

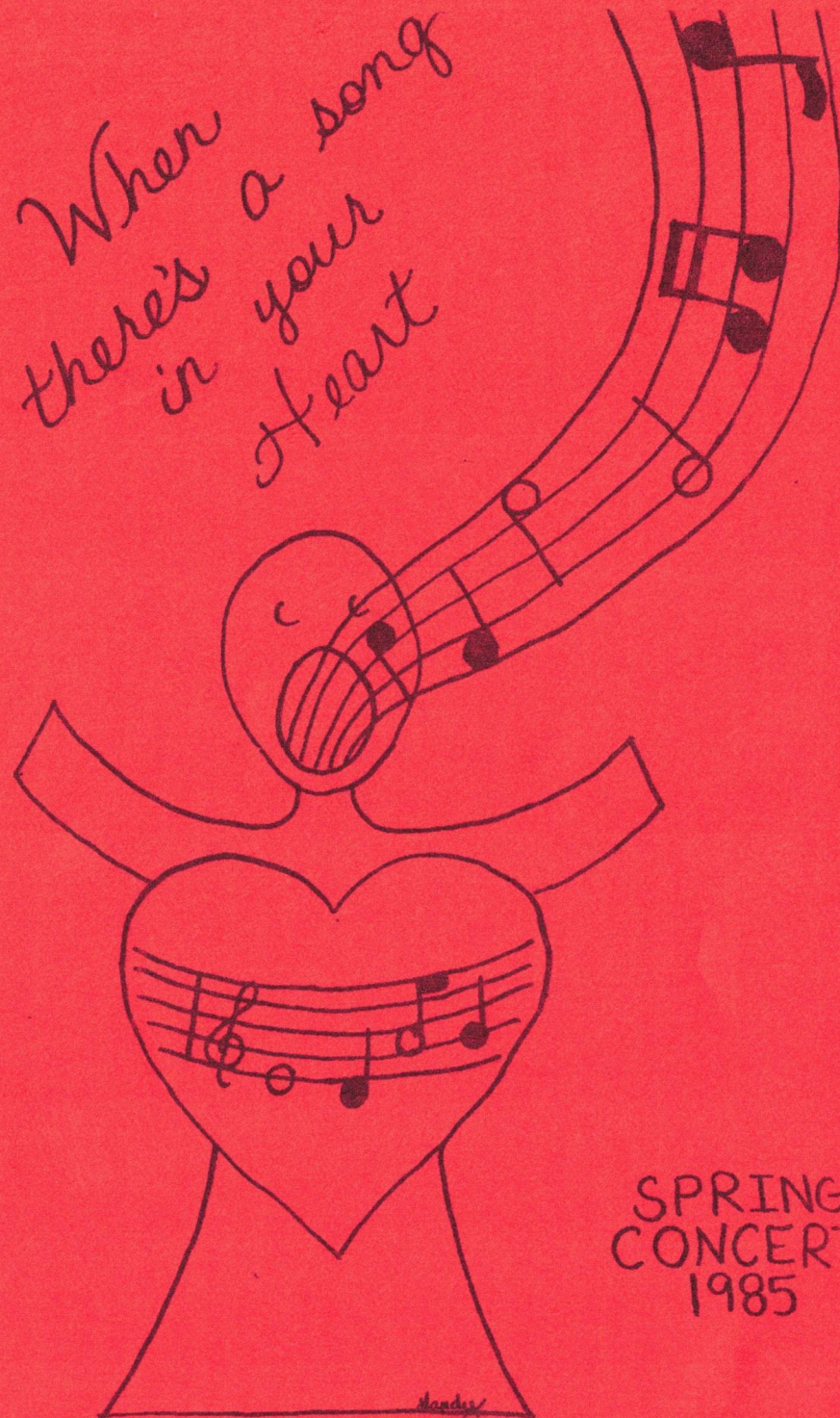

LUTHERAN HIGH NORTH SUMMER SPORTS PROGRAMS

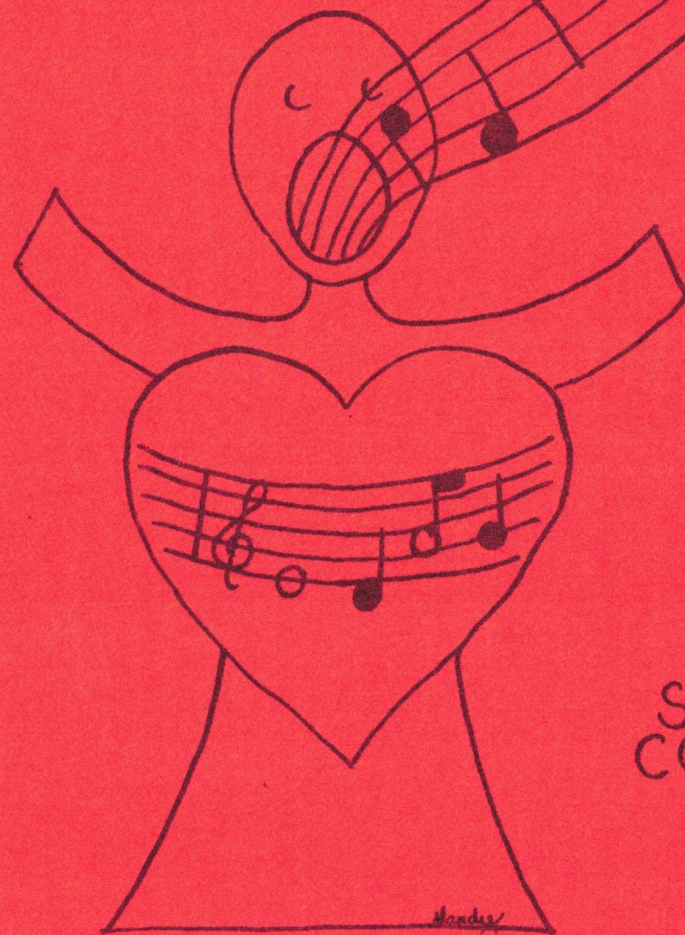
