Program Notes

Flourish For Wind Band

Ralph Vaughan Williams

Ralph Vaughan Williams premiered *Flourish for Wind Band* in London on April 1, 1939 as an overture to the pageant Music and the People. The work is characteristic of Vaughan Williams' style, and appealed to audiences of the time.

Morale in England was low during the Great Depression. Edward VIII created a scandal by giving up the throne to marry a twice-divorced American, and his brother, George VI, took over as monarch in 1936. Germany threatened to take over Europe and the British Isles. Unfortunately, much British music written in this period often alienated listeners

A few months before World War II a musical celebration was held to lift the spirits of the English. Although the April 1st date had previously commemorated King Edward's coronation, this celebration was in honor of music and the people and not intended for aristocrats and royalty. Vaughan Williams' *Flourish* premiered at the celebration but was not heard again until the 1970's. Even after its publication the piece was not mentioned in any sources listing his complete works.

Other band works of Vaughan Williams include *English Folk Song Suite, Sea Songs,* and *Toccata Marziale*. Each work are considered classics in band repertoire, and are the staple of quality band programs.

Robert W. Smith (b. 1958) is one of the most popular and prolific composers of concert band and orchestral literature in America today. He has over 500 publications in print. From professional ensembles such as the United States Navy Band and the Atlanta Symphony to school bands and orchestras throughout the world,

his music speaks to audiences in any concert setting. We have performed several of his pieces, including The Great Locomotive Chase.

Lauda Anima

This music is majestic and full of bold fanfares, depicting an atmosphere of royal pageantry. The basis of the work is a 19th Century hymn known as Lauda Anima, which roughly translated from Latin means, "to praise life." This hymn tune is found twice in our current Lutheran hymnody in Hymnal Supplement '98. Two verses of the hymn Praise My Soul the King of Heaven are printed in the program for your meditation during our performance.

Michael Staub is a 2002 graduate of Concordia University, Nebraska. Michael is in his third year as the conductor of the Lutheran High North Concert Band. He also leads the marching band, pep band, and musical orchestra. Mr. Staub also teaches band at Immanuel, Memorial, and Our Savior Lutheran Schools.

KeiCee Newton is a graduate of Southwest Texas State University and is in her second year as the director of choral activities at Lutheran High North. She conducts the Glory Givers, Concert Choir, and Women's Chorus as well as the vocal coach for the musical.


