Mr. William Owens is an accomplished composer who has previously worked with Lutheran High North students and continues to actively conduct and clinic bands throughout the United States.

Inspired by the composer's trip to California's Sequoia national park, *Crescent Meadow*, captures the tranquility, beauty and grandeur of this picturesque meadow in the heart of the Sequoia National Forest. A short section of contrasting style leads to a dramatic and breathtaking final statement. From there the work subsides, ending as it began, with uncommon sensitivity. He also serves as a staff arranger for the famed Ohio State University Marching BandWith over 500 published works, he has written band compositions and arrangements that reflect a variety of musical forms and styles. Many of his pieces, including 86 commissioned works, have been chosen for contest and festival lists, including *Blue Ridge Saga*, which has been on the Texas UIL list for many years.


